Please see below for the current status:

The contractor has been placing concrete on multiple city streets, including Park Avenue N, Hilltop Street, Centre Street, and Main Street W. Some work is still needed before completion and will likely be placed early next week. This will be the final mobilization for the concrete crews this year. Paving of these remaining streets will likely occur the following week. The contractor will then place remaining topsoil and seed as we near substantial completion for the street and utility reconstruction portion of the project.

As we reach completion, a punch list will be prepared of final work items to be addressed with the project over the next few weeks. This will likely include some minor concrete repairs, adjustments of sump baskets or other items in the right-of-way, and many other miscellaneous items.

Replacement of a storm sewer south of Hilltop Street may begin next week. Water main replacement on the south side of Crystal Valley may occur the following week. Work at the wastewater treatment facility will occur in November.

The contractor has seeded some areas of the project. They are responsible for the first 60 days of maintenance including watering every week. Residents may assisting with watering but should refrain from mowing the grass as it grows until it is at least 6 inches tall. The first mowings should be at the highest setting for the mower.
