This letter is being sent to inform you of construction activity on the above-referenced project. The contractor has completed concrete placement on the project and is preparing the remaining streets for paving. Bituminous paving crews are expected on Tuesday or Wednesday next week on Hilltop Street, East Street N, Park Avenue N, Centre Street N, and Main Street W. Topsoil and seeding will follow.

As we reach completion, a punch list will be prepared of final work items to be addressed with the project over the next few weeks. This will likely include some minor concrete repairs, adjustments of sump baskets or other items in the right-of-way, and many other miscellaneous items.

Replacement of a storm sewer south of Hilltop Street has started and will continue into next week. Water main replacement on the south side of Crystal Valley may occur the following week. Work at the wastewater treatment facility will occur in November.

The contractor has seeded some areas of the project. They are responsible for the first 60 days of maintenance including watering every week. Residents may assisting with watering but should refrain from mowing the grass as it grows until it is at least 6 inches tall. The first mowings should be at the highest setting for the mower.
