With work affecting residents on the project ending, this will be the final project update for the year.

The contractor has completed paving of project streets and is completing topsoil and general site cleanup within the project area.

As we reach completion, a punch list will be prepared of final work items to be addressed with the project over the next few weeks. This will likely include some minor concrete repairs, adjustments of sump baskets or other items in the right-of-way, and many other miscellaneous items.

Replacement of a storm sewer south of Hilltop Street is complete. Water main replacement on the south side of Crystal Valley has started and will continue through early next week. Later in October, the contractor will complete replacement of water valves in manholes located on TH169 which may require temporary water shutdowns; notices will be provided to affected property owners. Work at the wastewater treatment facility will occur in November.

The contractor has seeded some areas of the project. They are responsible for the first 60 days of maintenance including watering every week. Residents may assisting with watering but should refrain from mowing the grass as it grows until it is at least 6 inches tall. The first mowings should be at the highest setting for the mower. Overseeding throughout the project area will be provided in spring 2025 as needed.
